Minimum Eligibility

- Must be at least 21 years of age

- Type 35 wpm (attach testing certificate to application)
- Ability to multi task and remain calm under pressure
- Ability to competently and effectively handle non-emergency and emergency calls to the 911 dispatch
- Able to speak English well; a knowledge of Spanish helpful
- Must have a valid Driver License
- Must be willing to conduct themselves in accordance with the policies of the county and Sheriff's Office; Dispatcher code of ethics; and local, State and Federal Laws.
- Willing to perform other duties as assigned.
- Write reports, provide testimony, and facilitate evidence collection prior and during courtroom proceedings
- Willing and able to work flexible hours to include all varied shifts, nights, weekends and holidays, as required by the position. Subject to call outs and emergency activations
- Have demonstrated good moral character and pass a background investigation
- Be free of any physical, emotional, or mental condition that might adversely affect the performance of the applicant's duty as a dispatcher
